Summer Term 1 Ancient Egyptian Life

English

We begin our English learning with learning how to write a chapter book that will make our reader afraid. We will be basing the story in a forest using Roald Dahl's Billy and the Minpins as a text to rip from.

Maths

We are beginning this half term looking at fractions of different numbers including unit and non-unit fractions. Following this we will be moving onto learning about measurement with a focus on time. We will be exploring Roman Numerals, telling the time to one minute intervals on both the analogue and digital clock.

Science

This term we will be learning about light sources, sunlight, shadow formation, size and how they change throughout the day.

Humanities

This term we will be exploring how the ancient Egyptians lived. We will be researching the building of the pyramids, the different pharaohs that ruled during that time period and how their life impacts ours today.

PSHE

This unit will explore the theme of relationships, both at home and in school. We will look at different family make-ups, appreciating that all family units are different but serve the same purpose and role. We will look at the skills needed to form, develop and maintain successful friendships and relationships with their peers and other people in our lives.

Religious Education

Our learning this term will be focused on the Christian question 'What kind of world did Jesus want?' We will be thinking about how Jesus chose his followers and what his actions towards others means for us today.

Music

We will be continuing our unit of percussion and singing. We will also be learning how to play the recorder!

Art

This term we will be using our theme of Egyptians to influence our art work. We will learn how to draw a scarab beetle and learn how to use coloured pencils to blend and then use this knowledge to create our final piece.
