## **Family Consultation Meetings**

Dear Parents and Carers,

Our Family Consultation Meetings will take place on Wednesday 9th and Thursday 10th June between 3:40 - 6.40pm.

Each appointment will be **10 minutes long**, and you only need to make **one appointment** with each of your child's class teacher / teachers.

As in the Autumn Term, appointments will all be held **online (not in school)** using **Microsoft Teams**. Instructions as to how this will work are in this letter. If you think you will have a problem with this, our friendly office staff are on hand to help you book an appointment if you need assistance.

At Orchard Academy we encourage the children to play an active part in the consultation process. This is in order to put *them* at the centre of their learning, and to strengthen the link between home and school. This link is, of course, vital for ensuring the best possible learning outcomes for your child.

We understand that as parents and carers, you play a *vital* role in our children's education. It is for this reason that we politely ask that all parents ensure they do make an appointment to meet with their child's class teacher.

Since we are operating online, we will need to try our very best to keep 'on time' with our appointments, so please excuse us in advance if our teachers need to ask you to arrange another conversation so that they can be ready for their next appointment promptly.

You can book your consultation time directly using our online booking page. Please see below for instructions on how to do this.

If your child has an **Individual Education Plan (IEP)**, there will be an additional opportunity to discuss this with their class teacher and the school SENCO (Mrs. Clarke) on the week of 14<sup>th</sup> June. Further information about this will be sent to you after half term.

Please note that you will be unable to make or cancel a booking within 48 hours (2 days) of your appointment. This is to allow teachers to ensure they have all the relevant information about your child prior to the Consultation Meeting.



You can book an appointment with your child's teacher directly on our Family Consultation Meeting Booking page. Once you have watched the video above and read the following steps, please click the link below to reach the Booking Page:

- 1. Access the school Family Consultation Meeting Booking Page. You must book your appointment at least 2 days in advance.
- 2. Click the Year Group your child is in.



3. Using the calendar, click the date you wish to make an appointment. Each Year Group has 2 dates available.













Using the drop-down menu, select your child's class teacher.

6. Fill in the required information underneath the calendar and times, then click 'Book'.
