





Literacy

We will be continuing to practise our phonics and reading, building our knowledge of letter sounds, as well as recognising and blending sounds to make simple and complex words. We will also be focusing and engaging with these stories:

Purple: Monkey Puzzle, Mog the Forgetful Cat

Orange: The Gingerbread Man and Jack and the Beanstalk

Numeracy

In Purple class, we will be recapping multiplication, division, addition, subtraction, place value, shapes, position and direction. We'll use different objects and methods to help us. In Orange class, we'll be continuing to count to larger numbers, as well as working on our colour and shape recognition.

My World

This half term, we'll be learning all about the people who help us, how we can ask for help and how to recognise them.

Learning for Life

In cooking, we'll be making a variety of different savoury and sweet dishes. As part of this, we will be working on how to cook hygienically and how to use equipment correctly

Myself and Others

Some of Purple will be attending SRE PSHE interventions this half term, while the rest of us work together in class on our turn-taking and emotions. In Orange, we'll continue to practise our turn-taking and sharing, as well as social story interventions to keep us safe.

Communication and Language

Between our lessons, we will take part in various different activities that enable us to communicate how we feel as well as sharing and taking turns with others. This will include learning through play.

Music

We'll be using a combination of body percussion and instruments to make different sounds and join in with different songs we like.

We'll be using a combination of different materials and media, including those from the
