Curriculum

The aim of the curriculum at Orchard Academy is to provide an ambitious, motivating and enriched curriculum that meets the needs of all children, allowing them to explore and understand the world they live in. We provide opportunities for children to develop as independent and confident learners with high aspirations, empowering every child to become a responsible and successful citizen in the local and global community, becoming life-long learners.

Our curriculum incorporates the key knowledge, skills and understanding set out in the National Curriculum and other experiences and opportunities which best meet the learning and developmental needs of the children in our school, equipping them with high levels of literacy and numeracy and critical and creative thinking skills essential for now and in the future.

The curriculum is carefully planned with high expectations to ensure clear progression within all curriculum subjects and aims to support children in gaining a deeper understanding of their learning. Our children are provided with a firm grounding in core skills including, reading, writing, spelling, grammar and mathematics.

We ensure by the time children leave Orchard Academy they are equipped with the knowledge and skills to continue to learn and grow independently in the next stage of their learning journey.

Extra-curricular opportunities

Orchard Academy offers a varied programme of extra-curricular clubs for all pupils who wish to participate.

We understand the importance of enrichment opportunities and experiences. Children have the opportunity to learn both inside and out of the classroom, through themed days, whole school activities and opportunities within and out of school which enrich learning. We are a creative school and promote this across the curriculum.

A variety of after school clubs based on interests of our children and high-quality visits and visitors extend these opportunities further. Children have opportunities to share their learning with each other, their parents and carers and other learners through school-based performances, competitions and events involving other schools.

Aspen



Aspen is Orchard Academy and Shepherdswell Academy's Specialist Communication Department.

Children are allocated a place in Aspen by Milton Keynes Council. It is a requirement of the authority that the child has an EHC plan and that the child's main area of need is social communication. At present the department has twenty places for children at Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2.

As much as the department is focusing on the social communication needs of the children, we also pride ourselves on offering personalised teaching and support for each child.

The learning pathway of each child is individualised and bespoke to their needs. Staff work closely with each child to ensure that their physical environment, visual environment and adapted learning approaches work to build on each child's strengths and support them to achieve to the best of their ability and make progress from their starting points.

This could be your child accessing the department but attending specific lessons within the mainstream to the ability of your child's needs.

Performance



Orchard Academy was rated a **GOOD** school by Ofsted in its most recent inspection (July 2023)

inspectors found that Orchard is a welcoming and friendly school, where pupils know how to behave and what is expected of them and where they embrace difference and celebrate the wide range of faiths and diversity at the school.

Inspectors also recognised that school leaders have planned the curriculum in detail and that knowledge, skills and vocabulary are clearly mapped out.

The inspection report also highlighted the school's approach to ensuring pupils with special educational needs and/or disabilities (SEND) are fully included in school life.

It also noted that reading is a priority at Orchard Academy and highlighted the school's structured approach to teaching reading.

The report also praised the range of extra-curricular clubs and activities on offer at Orchard Academy which enhance the curriculum learning opportunities for the pupils.

Pupil Welfare

Orchard Academy is committed to delivering good outcomes for children and young people by providing a safe learning environment that promotes their welfare and helps them to develop socially and emotionally so that they can make the most of their life chances. This is achieved by:

- Providing a safe, healthy learning environment that allows them to develop to their full potential
- Safeguarding their welfare, particularly those children and young people who are most disadvantaged
- Providing young children and young people with opportunities to discuss issues and report problems affecting their safety and welfare
- Ensuring safe recruitment practices
- Ensuring robust procedures for recognition and referral where there are welfare or child protection concerns
- Raising awareness amongst staff of child protection issues and ensuring staff are equipped to deal with concerns
- Monitoring and supporting children and young people who are subject to child protection plans and contributing to the implementation of their plan
- Promoting partnerships working with parents and professionals

Wraparound Care



At Orchard Academy we offer before and after school provision for children in Year 3 to Year 6.

- Breakfast Club operates from 7.30 – 8.40am.
- After School Club operates from the end of the school day until 6:00pm.m. We do not accept entry from any child using breakfast club after 8:30am.

Our wraparound care is a welcoming and friendly environment for all children at Orchard Academy. Children are given choices to participate in a variety of arts and crafts, sports, team games, or simply just relax and read a book in the quiet area.

During Breakfast Club, children are provided with breakfast and at After School Club, children will be provided with a light snack. All menus for food at our extended care is carefully planned and shared with parents.

Booking is available allowing you to select the days you require. Once a booking has been confirmed the place is secure unless cancelled. Bookings and payments need to be made in advance for all sessions that are required to ensure a place for your child/ren.
