Re: Parking and Drop Off / End of Day Collection

Dear all.

We recognise how busy our community becomes at the beginning and the end of the school day, particularly around the roads directly adjacent to the school. We are also aware of the limited spaces available for parking.

Whilst we do not have the ability to change the infrastructure surrounding the school, we will work continually with Milton Keynes Council and our local Community Support Officers at Thames Valley Police to do what we can to keep our school and surrounding area safe.

With this in mind, we ask for all our school families to act with kindness and patience during the busy times of the school day, and in particular, take care and consideration when parking for collection at the end of the day, to ensure we all remain safe.

We ask that:

- All accompanied children must be kept with adults when crossing the roads.
- Please only park in assigned bays in the car park at the front of the school and avoid parking on the paths or curbs directly around the school with yellow lines.
- Please be considerate of our neighbours ensuring cars are not parked on their property or blocking access to their homes.
- Please show courtesy to other when manoeuvring vehicles and prioritise the movements of pedestrians to keep everyone safe.
