Spring Term 2 Volcanoes

English

This term, Year 3 are becoming authors and influencers! They'll craft thrilling stories inspired by real-life events—packed with drama and excitement—and learn how to write persuasive letters and emails that really make an impact. We can't wait to see their creativity shine!

Maths

This term the children will continue to build their confidence with multiplication and division. They will use grids to strengthen their understanding of how numbers combine. They will then move on to the column method for multiplication, preparing them for more formal written strategies. At the end of the term they will be exploring Money operations learnt to real-life contexts such as calculating totals and giving change.

Science

Year 3 will be learning about plants: their parts, what they need to grow, and how water moves through them. They will explore the life cycle, pollination, and seed dispersal, and carried out experiments to see how light and water affect growth.

Humanities

How can a tourist hotspot affect the local environment and the people who use it? This term the children will be building on their existing knowledge and promoting Milton Keynes as a hot spot to visit for tourists!

PSHE

This term, pupils are learning about healthy choices, staying safe, and building positive friendships. They'll explore exercise, balanced diets, food labels, and safety strategies, including how to call emergency services. Lessons also focus on managing feelings and making responsible decisions.

Religious Education

We will be learning about what it means to follow God through the story of Noah. Children will explore God's covenant (promise) with Noah, how this links to Christian wedding vows, and how these ideas can guide us in everyday life—keeping promises, caring for creation, and doing the right thing.

This term, Year 3 are exploring pneumatic systems by designing and building models that move using air pressure. Through this hands-on project, children learn how air can be compressed to create force and movement, linking science with creative design.
