Summer Term 1 Ancient Egyptian Life

English

We begin our English learning with learning how to write a chapter book that will make our reader afraid. We will be basing the story in a forest using Roald Dahl's Billy and the minpins as a text to rip from. Our second unit of work is based on free verse poetry. We will be reading performing and writing our own poems.

Maths

We are beginning this half term looking at statistics and how they are represented. We will explore, read, interpret and create our own range of data from pictograms to bar graphs. We will then spend 3 weeks revisiting fractions. We will be learning how to add and subtract fractions with the same denominator as well as embed our skills of finding fractions of a number.

Science

This term we will be learning about light sources, sunlight, shadow formation, size and how they change throughout the day,

Humanities

This term we will be exploring how the ancient Egyptians lived. We will be researching the building of the pyramids, the different pharaches that ruled during that time period and how their life impacts ours today.

PSHE

This unit will explore the theme of relationships, both at home and in school. We will look at different family make-ups, appreciating that all family units are different but serve the same purpose and role. We will look at the skills needed to form develop and maintain successful friendships and relationships with their peers and other people in our lives.

Religious Education

Our learning this term will be focused on the Christian beliefs of keeping the world created by God and how we can ensure we keep it how he intended. We will be discussing what a good deed might look like and how we can help those in need.

Music

We will be continuing our unit of percussion and singing. We will be learning to sing with greater accuracy, learn how to describe our preference for different styles of music genres and reasons why:
