English

We will revisit and review our narrative skills by creating our own Saxon-inspired short stories to entertain our teachers. We will then explore information texts on topics that interest us in order to create a class information book.

sh Maths

We will develop our Place Value skills working with numbers to at least I million, rounding them and multiplying and dividing by 10, 100 and 1000. We will secure written and mental methods for addition and subtraction and identify multiples, factors and prime numbers.

Science

We will be comparing and grouping together materials based on their properties. We will be working scientifically to carry out investigations to investigate hardness, thermal conductivity and solubility of materials.

Religious Education

We will be exploring what it means to be a Muslim in Britain today. We will explore the five pillars of Islam and look at why Zakah is important to Muslims and the importance of pilgrimage within the Islamic faith.

Humanities

This term we focus on history. Our Key enquiry will be: 'How did the Anglo-Saxons settlement change Britain?' We will find out where they came from and settled and look at what life was like for them in Britain.

Music

We are going to learn to keep a steady beat with body percussion to accompany different sea sharty style songs. We will also learn to play base notes and chords to accompany our class arrangements.

PSHE

In PSHE we will focus on the individuality of each member of the class, learning to work together and develop our cooperation skills. We will look at our rights and responsibilities as children, setting aspirational goals to help us achieve our ambitions.

Art

We will explore the artwork of Hundertwasser and Gaudi and use their ideas to help us create our own artwork. We will develop our drawing skills to design fantasy houses.

Computing

In Computing, we will be creating vector drawings using different drawing tools to help create images which can be used to create more complex pieces of work.
